

ARUMERU RIVER LODGE

Halfway between Moshi and Arusha, Arumeru River Lodge offers spacious rooms located in the heart of a vast tropical garden with trees. They offer visitors a space decorated with taste, clean and comfortable.

MANYARA NATIONAL PARK

Manyara National Park is the smallest park in Northern Tanzania (330 kmÇ with 230 kmÇ of lake).


It is advisable to visit early in the safari. The park makes a big appearance with the

seasons, but keeps a constant interest throughout the year.

The cliffs of the Rift Valley bordering the lake and give the park a beautiful setting. In this space come those fabulous flights of thousands of pelicans, ibis or flamingos. All around the lake, it's a carousel of colors and cries, a paradise through collective gusts whipping air stun you and brush the surface of the water during the flight groups.

Lake plains but also lush forest of acacia: landscape diversity goes hand in hand with an equally varied fauna. Wildebeests, zebras, hippos, elephants, antelopes ... If you're lucky, maybe you can surprise a lion resting in the heights of an acacia!





TARANGIRE NATIONAL PARK

Considered as one of the best refuge for Tanzanian wildlife, the Tarangire National Park is also famous for its elephants and baobabs.

Covering 2 600 kmÇ and peaking at 1 100m above sea level in average, the park host some difficult species to be observed in other parks. Such as the Gerenuk, the small Kudu, Oryx or even eland and kudu large.

Its name comes from the Tarangire River, which crosses the park from north to south. The vegetation is dominated by baobabs, martyred by the other colossus of the park: the hundreds of elephants. The spectacular park can suddenly become empty. The fauna is rich and varied but with some heavy rains, most of the animals desert the park. The park remains interesting all the year.

In the dry season, large herds of zebra and wildebeest focus on Tarangire River. In the rainy season, landscapes embellished by the rains, and the resident wildlife (elephants, giraffes, cats ...) offer a wonderful show.







BASHAY RIFT Lodge

Ideally located (just 8 km from the NCA entrance), the Bashay Rift Lodge is built on top of a hill. In the heart of a coffee plantation, the lodge enjoy a breathtaking view (360°) on the region extending the Ngorongoro foothills to the edges of the Rift Valley (Lake Eyasi).

Small structure of 26 rooms, furnished differently, the best opportunities are offered depending on whether you are a family or group of friends.


The Bashay Rift Lodge offers comfort worthy of a 4 star establishment. This address became a nice transition point in a circuit in the northern parks, but can also be a very relaxing stopover if you want to spend several nights.

Several activities from the Lodge can be offered : bike tour, coffee plantations or villages visits, excursion to Lake Eyasi or simple walk in the villages around the Lodge.

NGORONGORO CRATER

World Heritage of UNESCO, the site is certainly the most famous wildlife reserve in the world.

This caldera, 20 km in diameter, and the ramparts reaching 600m high is the refuge of exceptionally rich fauna and flora.

The Big Five may be observed here: buffalo, elephants, leopards, lions and rhinos.

For a safari in Tanzania it is impossible to overlook the Ngorongoro Crater. This is a "Must".

Ngorongoro Crater (second largest crater in the world by its diameter) is only a small part of the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, a vast region of 8.500Km.

Wildlife inside the crater is extraordinarily rich for such a small biotope (over 30 species of mammals), including the last black rhinos.

The best season is undoubtedly the months of April and May when the crater is covered with flowers, fauna is very dense and tourists are scarce.







OLDUVAI CAMP

With a capacity of 17 tents, harmoniously arranged around the central Kopjes, Olduvai Camp is the starting point for trekking tours: the simplest (ten minutes to admire the sunset over the Serengeti plains), to multi-day treks (along the Olduvai Gorge).

Each tent is comfortable with large beds (double or twin), small furniture, deck with safari chairs, adjacent to the tent sanitary part (toilet with running water, sink, hot shower).

The camp meets current environmental requirements: solar energy (light tents and heating water), waste recycling, water saving.

Olduvai Camp was awarded in 2011 the distinction of Best Camp by the French magazine "Hotel & Lodge".

Olduvai Camp remains a must if you want an unforgettable bush experience between Ngorongoro Crater and the vast plains of the Serengeti.



NGORONGORO CONSERVATION AREA

Unlike national parks, the Ngorongoro Conservation Area does not exclude all human life.

Indeed, this vast expanse of over 8 500 kmÇ, man and wildlife live here in harmony for hundreds of years.

Allowed to remain on their ancestral land, the Maasai perpetuate their traditional way of life of nomadic pastor.

The region offer many interesting places :

- The wildlife specific to this area
- The Olduvai site and museum
- The Maasaï villages, protected from occidental influence

• The geological curiosities such Nassera Rocks, Shifting Sands or the Olduvai Gorge.


Other sites of NCA:

All of our 16 tents were recently renovated and even though this is not a permanent structure as such, our guests find it very comfortable and suitable.


All tents face the plains and are all en suite.

SERENGETI NATIONAL PARK

The Serengeti National Park is huge (over 14,000 km). It offers a variety of remarkable landscape biotopes:

The SOUTH region is superb from December to May, when it hosts the great migration and predators. It is in this part that there are the "Kopjes", granite blocks, in the middle of the Great Plains and territories of big cats.

The CENTER Region (Seronera region), is very rich throughout the year. At times during heavy rainfall, the region, though, empties of its herbivores.

The WEST Region, area is superb throughout the dry season (July to November). Presence of large herds (wildebeest and zebras) and crocodiles along the river.

The NORTH Region interesting all year round contains important resident wildlife. In times of heavy rain (possible between January and May) this region, the highest Serengeti (1800 m), loses some of its interest.

The Serengeti ecosystem is the annual theater of the great migration. Approximately 3 million large mammals (mainly wildebeest and zebra, Thomson's gazelle, but also and Grant and other large ungulates) travel across this region in search of more fertile ground.





GRUMETI HILLS

Located in the Grumeti Game Reserve on the edge of Serengeti National Park, Grumeti Hills is built on top of a hill with amazing views over the park.

All of the 16 tents are spacious & comfortable. Both the internal and external designs are very modern. All tents are en suite.

Main areas are very impressive with a main building housing a bar, lounge, lobby and restaurant. Decoration is a lovely blend of modern inspiration and classic safari furniture.


Apart from regular game drives (the area is home to an abundant resident fauna) as well as the great migration which passes through the Grumeti area twice a year.

GRUMETI CONTROLLED AREA

At the northern border of the Serengeti, the Grumeti reserve hosts a sizable resident wildlife.

The GreatMigration can also be observed from late May / early June to late October /early November.

The area offers many activities:

• 4x4 game drive : a circuit of fifty kilometers can cover a wide area.

• Walking safari : 3 itineraries of varying duration (30 min in a day)

• Night game drive : The legislation

normally requires all vehicles to return to the lodge or camp at dusk, or around 18h. Excluding certain animal behavior are observable only after sunset. This is the advantage of this output.

• Cultural Tour : daily market town of Mugumu - very beautiful, very typical and little frequented by tourists. Fort Ikoma - German vestige.

In order to realize it, experience it and, above all fully appreciate it, we offer different types of vehicle. The best one to drive the African tracks is a four wheel vehicle.


Our four wheel vehicles:


- All cars have opening roof and individual seats, which insure comfort even on tough tracks.
